# Community Champion Award Categories

## **Schools Champion**

An individual who has made a difference in their local school. For example this could be through fundraising, spending time reading to pupils or acting as a school governor or anything else.

## **Young person Champion**

An individual or group of young people aged 21 or under who have made a difference to their community or inspired others through their achievements. This could be through fundraising, campaigning on important issues or helping others less fortunate or anything else.

## **Team Champion**

Local team or group of volunteers who make a difference to their community by raising quality of life for local residents. e.g a local charity or voluntary organisation that has made the community a better or safer place to live.

## **Good Neighbour Community Champion**

A neighbour who has given that extra bit of help to you to make your life easier and gives support during difficult times or who makes your community a better place to live.

## **Senior Community Champion**

An individual or group of people aged 60 + who have made a difference to their community. This could be through helping others less fortunate or through fundraising.

## **Sports Champion**

An outstanding coach who inspires people in the community to be more active or a club which provides sporting, social and recreational opportunities. Nominations are open to all charity or voluntary organisations, community groups and individuals.

## **Health and Wellbeing Champion**

Groups or projects which promote the improvement of health and wellbeing within their communities. It could be promoting healthy lifestyle or providing support to help people stop smoking or a project offering advice counselling and support for anyone with health issues. Nominations are open to charities, voluntary organisations, community groups and individuals.

## **Public Service Champion**

Public Service team or individual working in the community who will have gone that extra mile to provide help and support that has made a real difference to the area in which they serve.

## **Uniform Service Champion**

Team or individual from uniformed service. Either a team responsible for keeping the community safe or a person you can turn to in a crisis who has gone above and beyond expectations
